Recommended Precautions Before Receiving Housekeeping Services

Safeguard Valuable and Fragile Items

Please store or secure all valuable and fragile items to prevent any damage.

Review Your Home Insurance Policy

Verify that your insurance covers any outside cleaning services for your peace of mind

Catalogue and Store Fragile Items

Make and inventory of fragile or valuable items and store them if possible.

Accompany Caregiver on a Walkthrough

Walk through your home with the caregiver at the start of the visit to point out fragile items or items that should not be touched.

Homemaking Guidelines

Things to Note

- Classic LifeCare is not responsible for any mishaps or damage resulting from our services.
- Clients are expected to provide their own cleaning supplies, including cleaning gloves, etc. All equipment (eg: vacuums) should be in good working order.
- Services are limited to light homemaking duties to assist with home maintenance. Classic employees will notify you and our office if a request falls outside of their job duties.

Homemaking Tasks Include:

Kitchen

- Clean counters and sink
- Organize cupboards and counter tops
- Wash client's dirty dishes
- Wipe down fridge and stove
- Throw out expired food with permission
- Update grocery list, assist with shopping

Bedroom

- Change bedsheets and wash linens as needed
- Make bed and fluff pillows
- Dust furniture surfaces and clean mirrors
- Vacuum floor
- Empty garbage

Bathroom

- Wipe down sink, bath and toilet
- Shine mirror and taps
- Wash floors with a mop, around base and back of toilet
- Empty garbage

Den/Living Room

- Empty garbage
- Fluff cushions
- Dust furniture surfaces, ornaments, light fixtures, TV and table tops
- Vacuum carpet or mop floors

Laundry

- Do laundry as needed
- Fold clothes and put away
