# 1 A BETTER MODEL FOR PEDIATRIC HEALTH CARE IN SCHOOLS

All children, despite chronic and acute health complications, deserve to attend school – both for its learning and social aspects. When sick kids have to stay home, parents can't work and kids can't learn. Classic has more than 10 years of experience working with Alberta Health Services (AHS) as the top provider of pediatric health care in Calgary.

In 2024, two school boards in Calgary issued requests for proposals to contract their pediatric health care needs directly with a provider, as an alternative to AHS. Classic LifeCare was successful in both contests.

In Classic's experience contracting directly with school boards, care is set up in the schools similar to a nursing unit, where one nurse is in charge of the team of health care staff (LPNs and Health Care Workers) on site. Unlike a remote case manager coordinating care, our on-site nursing managers are responsive, especially when someone calls in sick. They can fill in on the spot, so care is not disrupted.

**Because of this change in approach, missed visits have decreased by 98.54% in just two years. That equates to a reduction from 3.87 missed visits per student receiving health care to 0.01 missed visits per student receiving health care.**

With Classic providing pediatric health care directly to the school districts in Alberta using this proven approach to scheduling, and with the astronomical reduction in missed visits, three benefits are achieved:

1. Kids in need of health care can still attend school;
2. Stronger, stable families are able to work with fewer disruptions; and
3. Teachers and education assistants (EAs) can focus on education, not health care.

## Supporting Education Assistants (EAs) in the Classroom

After over a decade of working in Alberta schools, we've seen firsthand how dedicated Education Assistants (EAs) go above and beyond to support students—including those with complex medical needs. However, many of these responsibilities fall outside their formal training and scope of practice, which can lead to added stress, burnout, and risks to student care.

By partnering with Classic LifeCare, schools can ensure that medically complex children in schools receive care from trained health professionals. This allows EAs to stay focused on educational support, reduces their risk of burnout and sick leave, and helps create clearer role boundaries—all of which contribute to a more effective and sustainable learning environment.

In fact, by streamlining responsibilities, schools may be able to optimize staffing—ensuring EAs are used where they're needed most: in education, not health care.



## 2 PEDIATRIC EXPERTISE

Classic LifeCare has a long history of providing traditional home care, primarily for seniors. But over the years, we've expanded our expertise to serve a wider range of clients, **including pediatric care, workplace health & safety (OH&S), and nursing foot care.** Of these, pediatric care has become one of our most defining specialties.

In 2013, **Alberta Health Services (AHS)** put out a 'Request for Proposals' for pediatric health care in Calgary. Classic LifeCare won the contract and jumped in with a small but dedicated team, quickly adapting to the complexities of caring for children with disabilities at home.

Working closely with AHS, we developed specialized pediatric training for our nurses- training that continues to evolve as we refine best practices and respond to the unique needs of children and families we support.

Over the next decade, our pediatric program grew steadily. Then, in 2024, individual school boards took over the responsibility of contracting care for their students.

Today, we continue to work with AHS, directly support school boards and partner with funders like Family Support for Children with Disabilities (FSCD) and Children and Family Services (CFS). Through these partnerships, Classic LifeCare has proudly become the go-to provider for pediatric health care in Calgary.

#### ***A Classic LifeCare Case: Client-Centered Care for Carter***

Carter attended a farm school in rural Alberta outside of Calgary. Although not a typical arrangement, Classic LifeCare said, "Yes" to supporting Carter at home and during his involvement at farm school.

A flexible and dedicated Classic LifeCare care Workers (pictured right) supported Carter amidst farm animals, an outhouse and mud up to her knees some days.

As Carter's health declined and became palliative, Classic was able to connect with the greater care team and physician involved. Everyone adjusted as Carter's health required, while care shifted to less school and more home. Carter passed away at home with his parents present, as well as the Classic LifeCare Care Workers, who had cared for him throughout his health journey.

# 3 PROVEN PARTNERSHIPS

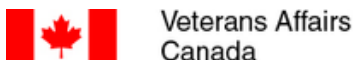
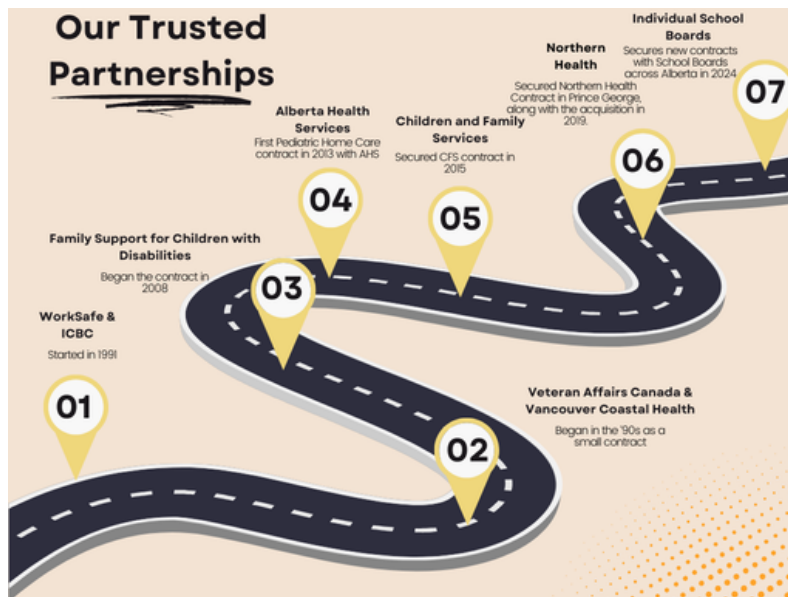

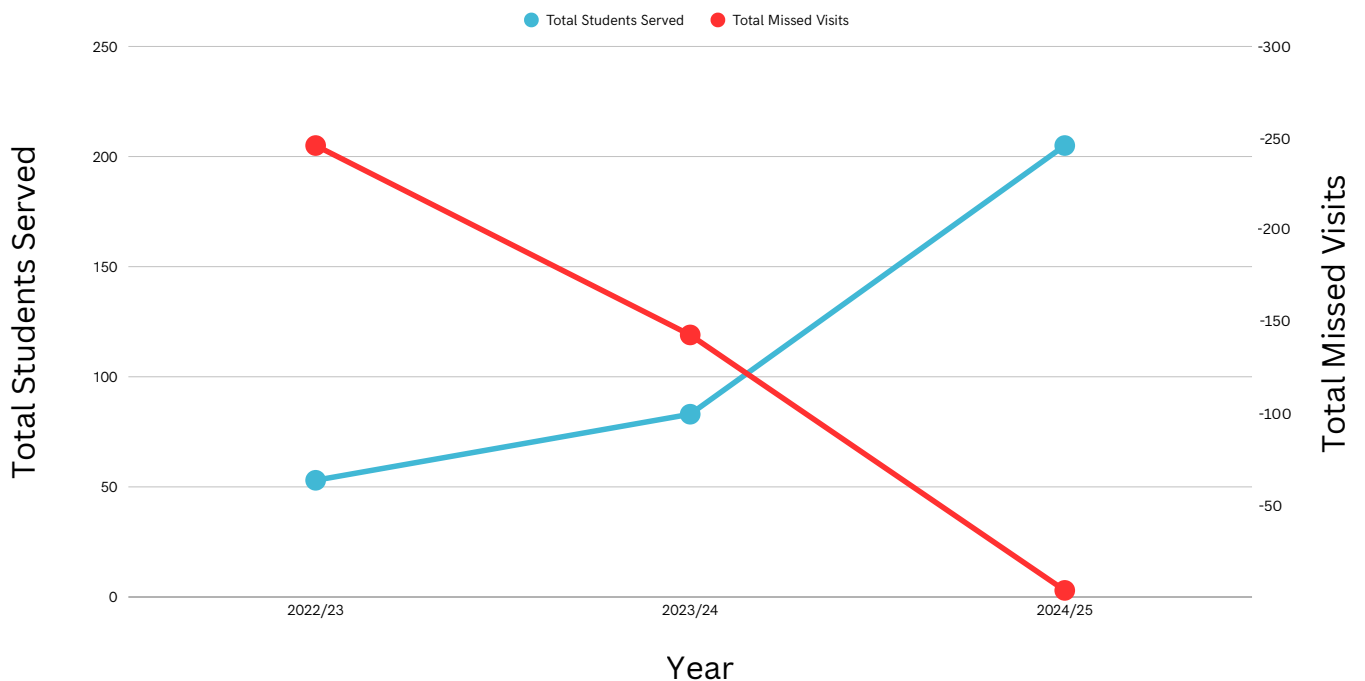
## Overview

### Missed Visits Per Client

Adjusting for client growth, the graph below shows a dramatic decrease in missed visits per client over time:

22/23: **3.87** missed visits per client

23/24: **1.43** missed visits per client

24/25: **0.01** missed visits per client

### Key Factors Contributing to Success

- **Communication:** Contracting directly with school districts streamlines communication, allows for strong relationship building and reduces red tape.
- **Enhanced Modeling:** An on-site case manager (Clinical Nursing Supervisor) provides leadership, responsiveness and instant coverage for sick calls (less missed visits).
- **Best practice case management:** Classic has the expertise to provide holistic medical management for students. We have float staff and on-site supervision to cover sick calls and ensure consistent, reliable health care for students.

### Summary

Despite a rapidly growing client base, the data shows a clear and steady decline in missed visits—underscoring Classic LifeCare’s commitment to consistent and dependable care. The focus moving forward is to maintain this low rate while continuing to expand our range of services.

Classic LifeCare began in 1974 as a nanny agency. As more and more women entered the workforce and needed support for their aging parents, Classic evolved into a home care provider. Originally known as Classic Caregivers, the company eventually became Classic LifeCare, reflecting its broader mission of providing care at every stage of life.

Over the years, Classic has grown through key milestones, strategic expansions, and an unwavering dedication to quality care. A pivotal moment came in 1998 when John Sherwood took over the business after his mother, Janet Sherwood - Classic's founder - fell ill. His leadership ensured the culture of exceptional care Jan built continued to thrive.

The company expanded to Alberta in 2005, and nearly a decade later, it established a strong focus on pediatric care. Today, Classic LifeCare is one of Vancouver's longest-standing home care agencies, with locations in Vancouver, Comox, and Prince George in BC as well as Calgary in Alberta. Serving clients of all ages, from pediatrics to geriatrics and everyone in between, Classic remains committed to delivering care that feels like family.
